

ROTARY IN TAIWAN

Rotary was introduced to Taiwan in 1931 with the formation of the Rotary Club (RC) Taihoku, sponsored by RC Tokyo. However, the first three clubs, namely RCs Taihoku, Takao, and Keelung, ceased operations in 1940 due to World War II.

In 1948, RC Taipei was established by community leaders in Taipei and former Rotarians from mainland China's dissolved clubs during the civil war. In



1960, Rotary International designated District 345 for the 19 clubs in Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan. Since then, Rotary has grown steadily on the island, forming District 3460 in 1978, District 3470 in 1984, District 3480 in 1987, and District 3490 in 1990. By 1998, all clubs were reorganized into seven districts, which increased to twelve districts by 2017.

In the Rotary Year 2023-24, membership in Taiwan grew to 35,117 Rotarians across 994 clubs, with a net gain of 30 clubs and 1,365 members. That year, they contributed a total of US\$ 21,299,872 to the Rotary Foundation, ranking Taiwan as the third-highest contributing country. Additionally, they supported Global Grants with \$5.8M and District Grants with \$1.8M donated from Taiwan. These efforts reflected the annual theme "Light Up Rotary" of 2014-15 RI President Gary C.K. Huang, the first Chinese RI President from Taiwan. Taiwan hosted the Rotary International Convention in Taipei in 1994 and will host another in 2026. They have also hosted Rotary Institutes in Taipei and Kaohsiung multiple times and will host another in Taipei in November 2024.
